The recommended vaccines and the schedule of their administration are the results of years of scientific study and data gathering on millions of children by thousands of our brightest scientists and physicians.

It is for these reasons that All Star Pediatrics requires all parents to vaccinate their children according to the recommended schedule. While we are happy to answer questions and discuss the safety and efficacy of the vaccines, if parents chose to deviate from the accepted schedule and to delay beginning routine vaccination by the time their child is 2 months old, they will be discharged from our group and be expected to find a different primary care source.
